WHEREAS, the Florida Supreme Court has issued administrative order SC11-44, terminating the statewide managed mediation program for residential mortgage foreclosure cases effective December 19, 2011;

NOW THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM A. PARSONS, Chief Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, hereby order that the Seventh Judicial Circuit Court's mandatory managed mediation program for residential mortgage foreclosure cases be terminated immediately.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no new cases may be referred to the managed mediation program, but that cases already referred and pending will remain in the program through completion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Administrative Order CV-2010-022-SC (A) is hereby rescinded.

Nothing in this Order prohibits judges from referring residential mortgage foreclosure cases to mediation on a case-by-case basis.
